

Summary of the Sequence of Requirements for the Master's Degree (**Effective June, 2007**)

1. ACS Placement Examinations
 - **Expected to perform well in at least 3 Chemistry divisional placement exams**
2. Coursework (minimum 18 credit hours required before candidacy)
 - 3 Courses from sub-discipline (division)
 - 2 Courses (1 each from two other divisions)
 - 1 Graduate-level Professional Development Course
3. English Competency and Expository Writing
4. Responsible Conduct of Research Workshop
5. Selection of Research Advisor/Project and Advisory Committee
6. Thesis Proposal and Thesis Research
7. Application, and Admission to Candidacy
8. Completion of at least 30 (coursework + research) credit hours
9. Thesis Completion
10. Final Oral Examination
