## Scholarships

- Scholarships and grant awards from Howard University funds are available only to students who complete the Free Application for Federal Students Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA may be secured from the Howard University Office of Financial Aid, high school guidance counselors, and public libraries. The FAFSA must be submitted before February 1<sup>st</sup>.
- After analysis of the student's file by the Office of Financial Aid, recommended funding from the Department of Music may be reduced depending on other funding sources (such as family income, Federal grants, etc.) or University and/or Federal regulations.
- Because of limited funds, the Department of Music cannot award full scholarships.
- Music scholarships are granted for one semester or one year only.
- Students must re-apply for scholarships each year. The Department of Music does not guarantee a specific scholarship amount from year to year.
- Financial aid is only granted to students who have been admitted by the Howard University Office of Admissions and the Department of Music (by audition).

### Special Talent Scholarships

Music Major eligibility requirements include:

- A minimum 2.5 Grade Point Average (GPA) including the prior semester.
- Music Department Scholarship Applications must be submitted by April 15<sup>th</sup> each year.
- Full-time enrollment status (minimum 12 hours).
- Participation in a departmental ensemble or accompanying.

### Trustee Scholarships

Students must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA for at least two consecutive (fall and spring) semesters.
