

## MAJOR TYRA S. SELLERS

Major Sellers is a native of Chicago, Illinois. She enlisted into the Army in November 1990 as an Administrative Specialist completing both Basic and Advanced Individual Training at Fort Jackson, South Carolina. Major Sellers was later commissioned as a Quartermaster Officer in 1995 after graduating from Officer Candidate School at Fort Benning, Georgia.

As a Second Lieutenant, she was assigned as a Platoon Leader and Accountable Officer with the 558<sup>th</sup> Transportation Company at Fort Eustis, Virginia. While still assigned to Fort Eustis, she became the Detachment Commander, S1/S4 of the Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 71<sup>st</sup> Transportation Battalion. As a Captain, she was assigned to Camp Red Cloud, Korea as the Supply and Services Officer and the Deputy Support Operations Officer. While still in Korea, she was assigned as the Commander of the 473<sup>rd</sup> Field Services Company headquartered at Camp Casey. Following the assignment to Korea, Major Sellers was assigned to the Army Logistics Management College at Fort Lee, Virginia as an Advance Course Instructor for the Combined Logistics Captains Career Course (CLC3). Major Sellers then went on to command the Norfolk Recruiting Company in Norfolk, Virginia. Following her command, Major Sellers was assigned to Camp Buehring, Kuwait as the Support Operations Officer with the Base Support Battalion supporting OIF and OEF. Her next assignment was as the Wartime Host Nation Support Officer with the 501<sup>st</sup> Sustainment Brigade headquartered at Camp Carroll, Korea. Major Sellers has most recently served as a Logistics Officer and then as the Petroleum and Water Branch Chief with United States Army Central Command (3<sup>rd</sup> Army) at Fort McPherson, Georgia. While assigned to Fort McPherson Major Sellers was deployed to Afghanistan and Kuwait in support of OIF and OEF.

Major Sellers' education includes an MBA with a Minor in Human Resources from the University of Phoenix (2008) and a Bachelor of Arts in Business Management from Saint Leo University (2001).
